These buckets are also 50 percent deeper as opposed to the quick-tach bucket models. This extra room makes them ideal for lifting irregular shaped loads like tearing off roof trash, elevating roof gravel, moving large debris piles, broken up concrete and backfilling behind walls.

The Quick-Tach can pour materials about 1.5 feet higher due to the shorter depth of its bucket.
